The injury categories are traumatic brain injuries, permanent spinal cord injuries, multiple or high-level limb amputations, permanent brachial plexus injuries, serious burns and permanent blindness caused by trauma.

Who can complete this form?

This form can be completed by the injured person or another person who is acting for them. This person must be 18 years or older.

Important - If you do not complete all sections of this form this may delay our decision on whether to accept the injured person as a participant in NIISQ.

This form collects sensitive and personal information to allow NIISQ to perform our functions in accordance with the NIISQ Act. The information will be managed in accordance with the Information Privacy Act 2009. Please read the detailed privacy notice at the end of this form for more information.
